15A	AWARD for BEST MINIATURE ORCHID FLOWER, OTHER THAN EQUITANT ONCIDIUM TYPE AND SLIPPER TYPES. Maximum 4" leaf and bulb, excluding inflorescence. Intended for plants such as Pleurothallis, Masdevallia, Sophronitis, Leptotes, etc. species and hybrids. NOTE— ENTRY REQUIRED—EXHIBITOR MUST COMPLETE A SEPARATE GREEN REGISTRATION FORM FOR THIS AWARD in addition to the Green Registration Form in the appropriate Individual Plant Class. AWARD 1st Place, Ribbons for 2nd and 3rd Place
16A	AWARD for the BEST ORCHID SPECIES FLOWER EXHIBITED BY AN NOS HOBBY GROWER. Plant must be entered in Individual Plant Class for consideration. No additional entry required.
