Registration Requirements for Commercial Floor Exhibits—Class O

1. All Commercial Floor Exhibits must be registered by completing a **Green Tag** and presenting it to the Registration Clerk before 4:30 pm on Thursday. **Absolutely no entries after 5:00 PM.**
2. All entries must remain in place for the duration of the show.
3. Precaution is taken for the safety of exhibits; however, the Society will not be responsible for damage, loss or theft.
4. Exhibitors are asked to remove exhibits promptly at 4:30 PM, Sunday, the day the show ends, so that exhibit take-down can proceed starting at 5:00 PM.

General Requirements for Commercial Floor Exhibits—Class O

1. Open by application only.
2. Class O will be awarded trophies for First, Second and Third Place
3. Exhibitors shall furnish all freestanding backgrounds, foliage plants, staging, and display materials.
4. Exhibit space is 8' x 8' x 10' high maximum, approximately 64 square feet. **(THE HEIGHT RESTRICTION WILL BE RIGIDLY ENFORCED—NO EXCEPTIONS)**
5. NOS will not furnish foliage plants for display backgrounds or displays but will provide self-standing cloth barriers between the floor exhibits.
6. All plants must be correctly and prominently labeled.
7. Wood, stone, metal, ceramic, and glass accessories and small battery powered electric lights (those are lights powered by dry cell batteries that would typically be found in a watch or hearing aid, or 9-volt, AAA, AA, A, C, or D only) contained within the exhibit are permitted.
8. The following materials are **NOT** permitted in Floor Exhibits: Cut Flowers, Flowering plants other than orchids, artificial or dyed plant material, water displays, additional lighting.
9. Electricity is available for vendors' sales booths only.
10. Name your exhibit! Submit a completed **Green Tag** to the Registration Clerk on Thursday before 4:30pm. Exhibit Title should be displayed. Exhibitor's names will be displayed only after judging is completed.
11. All exhibitors are asked to be familiar with the general show and exhibition rules as published in the NOS Show Schedule.
12. Precaution will be taken for the safety of plants and accessories; however, the Society will not be responsible for damage, loss, or theft.
