- President Dick Pippen called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.
- Secretary presented the minutes of the last meeting. Motion to approve minutes by Susan Roehl, second by Marilyn Moser, passed unanimously.
- President Dick reported that the Gallipeau sale went well and we presented Mrs. Gallipeau with over \$800. Dick was disappointed that more members did not show up. The remaining orchids were either sold at the last meeting or donated to Everglades Wondergarden. Dick read a thank note from Mrs. Gallipeau. She also donated \$300 to NOS. Secretary will send acknowledgement.
- Dick reported that Art Stone Orchids will be the fourth vendor for the show. Norm also pointed out that Michael Poulen of Art Stone Orchids will speak at the October meeting.
- Glen Stacel, of Friends of Fakahatchee, asking for a donation for their shade house project and advice on construction. Discussion: we gave them a donation a few years ago. Motion by Patrece Remmel to donate \$500, seconded by Kim Pendleton. Vote: 11 for, 1 against. Motion passed. Dick will find out when they need the funds.
- Several board members expressed their approval of the presentation by Prof Zettler at the last general meeting. They felt it was a good presentation to show members how our funds are being used.
- Treasurer Bill Overton presented the financial reports. checking \$9,455.92; investments \$14,803.22.
- Bill suggested using the Gallipeau donation to fund a scholarship for the culture class. Another suggestion was to name an award at the show in his honor. Tabled.
- Bill noted that we have not been supporting our Orchid judging center financially. Sue Roehl mentioned that we have given an annual lunch for the judges in past years. Bill mentioned that other societies make annual donations. Dick volunteered to look into whether we should make a donation, but subtly, since they have not sent us a request.
- Norm Dolder reported that the shade house has switched to well water and it is full of iron. This is staining the plants. Norm will talk to the owners and see if the water can be switched back to city water. He will report back.
- Deborah Gallagher and Lanelle Bishop reported on the proposal for a new raffle to be held at the meetings, as a separate raffle from the raffle for plants. The proposal is attached to these minutes. Discussion ensued. Bill suggested a price of \$2 per ticket and 3 for \$5. Sue Roehl volunteered to work the table. Lanelle and Deborah will work to procure items for the raffle. Drawing after green tag plant drawing. Plan to try the raffle for 6 months. Motion by Susan Roehl to conduct raffle as proposed with Bill's pricing, seconded by Deborah Gallagher, passed unanimously.
- Deborah Gallagher left the meeting.
- Membership Chair Nanett Boerner reported that membership is now 229.
- Kris Morton reported that newsletter is about ready to go.
- Patrece Remmel reported that the bookmarks are being finalized. Once approved, how many do we want to print? Patrece will get pricing and report to Dick. Motion by Kim Pendleton to print bookmarks, Bill Overton seconded, passed unanimously.
- Kris Morton mentioned that the Naples Botanical Gardens has again invited us to be the Orchid Doctors for their event in the fall.
- Kim Pendleton reported that we need more gold ribbons. Dick will check the storage. If there are none, Bill will order 50 from Ribbons Galore. Bill and Dick will do inventory of ribbons. Kim will be absent from the August meeting but her replacements are ready to go.
- Sue Roehl reported that she updated the website.
- Old business: Marilyn Moser reported that she researched donations of orchid-themed items for the Christmas party, to be raffled in either a silent auction or some other form of raffle. Motion by Cynthia Carlson to have Marilyn Moser to run a special auction at the Christmas Party, seconded by Bill Overton, passed unanimously.
- The Fall sale is Nov 16, 2013. (prep on Fri, Nov 15)

- President Dick Phippen called the meeting to order at 7:05pm. (rain delay)
- Secretary presented the minutes of the last meeting. Motion to approve minutes by Kim Pendleton, second by Marilyn Moser, passed unanimously.
- Dick Phippen reported that all vendors for the Show have responded, three have committed and most have paid. RF Orchids declined, so there is one more vendor slot open. Dick recommends Artstone & Palmer Orchids. Norm suggested Odom Orchids. Discussion ensued. Motion to invite Artstone/Palmer orchids to be the vendor by Marilyn Moser, seconded by Bill Overton, passed unanimously. Dick will contact.
- Dick contacted the widow of George Gallipeau. Dick recommends a sale on 6/29. The orchids (about 100) have been prepped. Dick would like us to have this sale for the widow's benefit. This will be announced in the newsletter. Volunteers are needed Fri and Sat.
- Dick proposed setting up a Benevolence Committee to assist surviving spouses with selling orchid collections. Patrece made motion, Sue Roehl seconded, passed unanimously. Bill and Ralph volunteered.
- Treasurer's report: Bill presented a financial report attached to these minutes.
- Norm Dolder reported that Prof Zettler is speaking at the July meeting and there are no raffle plants and no green tag plant. Dick said he would get the green tag plant and Norm and Patrece will buy the necessary raffle plants (budget \$130).
- Deborah Gallagher reported that she and Lanelle have an idea for a new raffle at the meetings. Discussion ensued of ideas. Dick asked for a committee to be formed (Deborah and Lanelle) and for them to present an idea at the next meeting. Sue Roehl volunteered to run the other raffle.
- Nanett Boerner reported that there are now 224 members.
- Kris Morton reported that she is in contact with John Brady who is working on Everglades Wonder Gardens. They would like NOS to get involved and help save EWG. Master gardeners are getting involved. They are working to get orchids and bromeliads in the trees. See attached press release.
- Patrece Rimmel presented the design for the new bookmark. Ralph suggested the design should include more types of orchids. There were other suggestions. Patrece will make the changes and bring back a revised design next board meeting.
- Lanelle Bishop reported that she is concerned about viruses and the probability that viruses are being spread through our sale and meetings. Kit read an email from a colleague of Dr. Zettler, Dr. Cory, who would like to collect samples to test for viruses. The testing is free. An email blast will be sent out to the membership regarding this offer.
- Ralph Brand had no report.
- Kim Pendleton had no report.
- Marilyn Moser reported that she has received our AOS membership card. We also received a letter from RF inviting us to visit July 12-14 for their annual summer sizzler sale.
- Sue Roehl reported that Marilyn did an excellent job on the pictures. She had a computer fry but is back up and running and has made all the changes to the website. Next month Sue will start circulating clipboards for sale volunteers.
- Old business: none.
- New business: Marilyn suggested that members may have various orchid-themed items that they would like to donate for NOS to sell at the sale or to silent auction at the Christmas party. Marilyn asked for an announcement in the newsletter. Dick asked for a committee to handle with Marilyn as chair. He asked that she report back next meeting.
