The matching program for the scholarship fundraising has been frustrated by the US consulate not issuing visas to any Cubans. But the research program will continue with others from IL College. Donations have been received (Kit read names). Still need to match \$645. Raised \$2,337 so far. This will fund 2 students for the research program. Total member donations of \$8124 to date since we started in 2011. \$34,500 has gone to fund education and research on native and related orchids.

David Orr reported on the raffle at the show, raised \$2,803. One of the winners of a basket was Rose, the wife of the former owner of the shade house we rent.
